Rules & Conditions

Entries must be made by post or email via our website at: www.ledstonequine.co.uk/dressage.html. Entries close at **12 noon on the Wednesday prior to the competition**. Competitors must only call for their times on 01977 668200 **between 12 noon & 4pm on the Friday prior to the competition**. Refunds are only available up until 12 noon on the Wednesday prior to the competition, unless the class is cancelled. Rosettes are awarded to sixth place. The organisers shall not be liable for any claims in respect of damage or accident to any person, whether competitor, servant, spectator, horse, vehicle or property howsoever caused in conjunction or arising out of the competition. All classes will be performed in conjunction with British Dressage rules. It is **MANDATORY** for all competitors/ riders to wear a helmet to British standard EN1384, ASTM F1163 or PAS015 **at all times** when mounted on LEC property. Lungeing is not permitted by competitors anywhere on LEC property. **Dogs** are to be kept on leads **at all times** and **must not** be brought into the indoor arena viewing gallery. Smoking is not permitted anywhere on the premises. All horses must be vaccinated to date and not be carriers of any infectious or contagious diseases. Passports must be available for inspection on number collection at secretary's desk. Warm up is to take place in designated area only. The judge's decision is final. Any competitor under 18 must be accompanied and supervised by an adult at all times. The management and organisers reserve the right to alter/ amend the rules at their discretion.
